



HSC Youth Grant Guidelines

The HSC Youth Grant is supported by Hemlock Semiconductor Operations, LLC and the Bay Area Community Foundation, the Midland Area Community Foundation, and the Saginaw Area Community Foundation.

Grant Amount - \$500

Eligible Groups:

- Must have an HSC Sponsor
- Must be made up of YOUTH in the K-12 age range
- Must be located in Great Lakes Bay Region
- Must be affiliated with a 501 (c) (3) or school district (public or private)
- Must complete an **approved** Volunteer Activity within 12 weeks of applying for the grant
- Must show demonstrated **need**

Volunteer Activities:

- Must take place in the Great Lakes Bay Region
- Cannot be fundraising related
- Must involve a minimum of 8 YOUTH volunteers
- Must be a minimum of 3 hours per student (total of 24 hours)
- Must not benefit the organization or school with which the youth group is affiliated
- Must be impactful and meaningful to all involved

Demonstrated Need:

- Must be able to explain what the grant funding will be used for and why it is needed
- Examples: Team Uniforms, Group Supplies, Registration Fees, etc.

Other:

- Grants are not made out to individuals
- All participants must sign the provided Photo/Media Release Form
- Groups can receive a maximum of one HSC Youth Grant per calendar year
- Application Deadlines are January 1, June 1, and September 1
